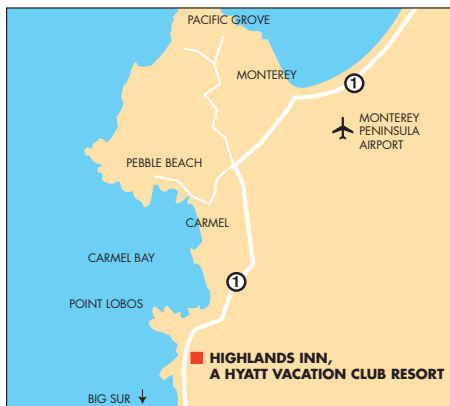

### DIRECTIONS

**From San Francisco area:** Take Highway 101 South through Gilroy to Prunedale; proceed to Highway 156 West to Monterey Peninsula (Highway 156 turns into Highway 1); go south to Monterey/Carmel (Highway 1 will change from a freeway to a road with traffic lights); hotel located 4 miles from Carmel on Highway 1. Look for the fourth traffic light at Rio Road and continue south on Highway 1 for 3 1/2 miles to Highland Drive on left.

### POINTS OF INTEREST

- **Carmel Area**—Explore Point Lobos, Carmel Beach and the mansions along Ocean Avenue; visit art galleries, restaurants, wineries and Carmel Mission, one of two minor basilicas in the U.S.; shop in beautiful Carmel-By-The-Sea; enjoy horseback riding and hiking in Garland Ranch Park.
- **Big Sur**—The magnificent coastline south of Carmel on U.S. 1 is a perfect spot for a day of sightseeing, whale watching, hiking and horseback riding
